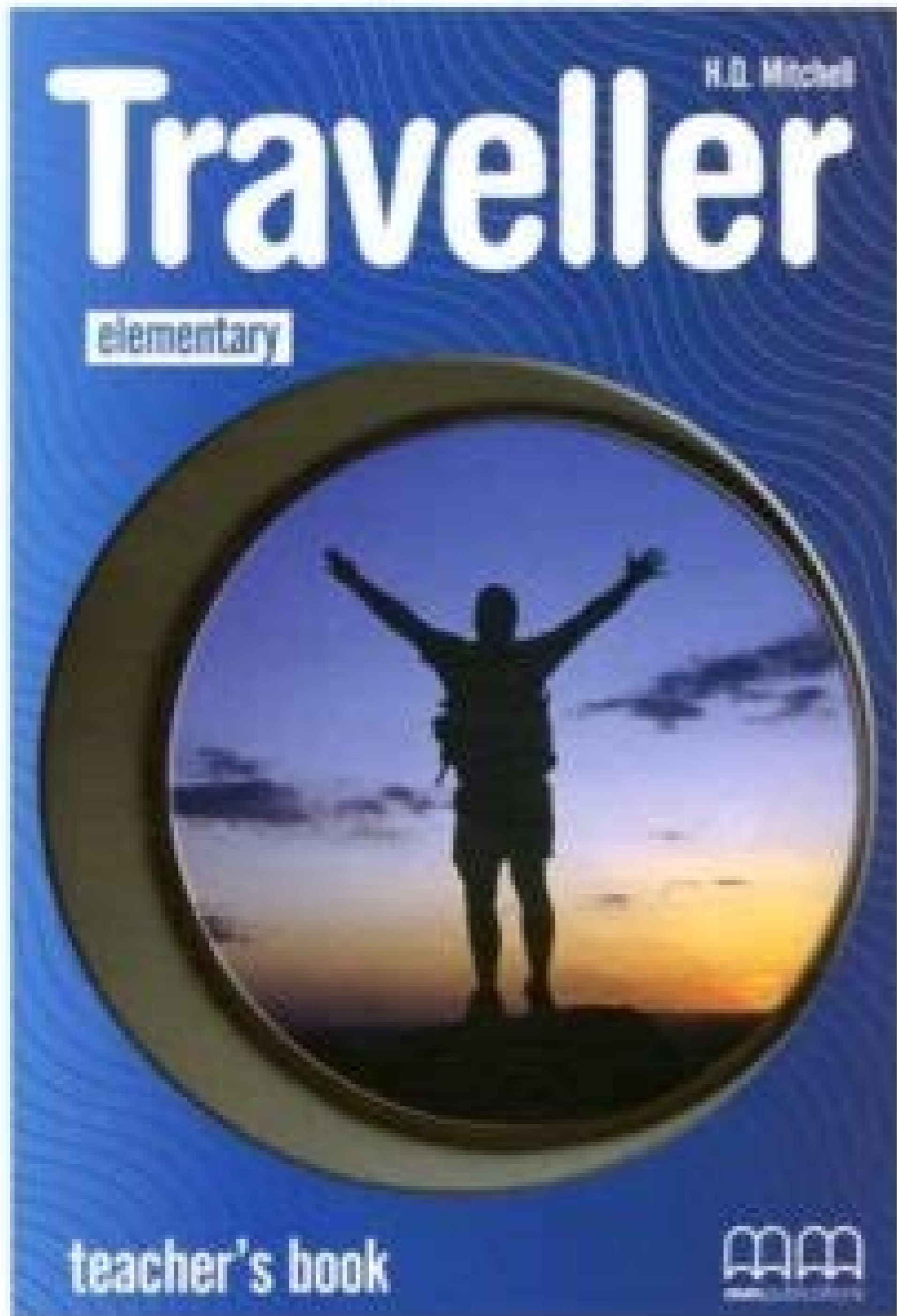

The walls are brightly coloured with cartoon characters and phrases; they are considered to be works of art. During the tour, the guide points out various important landmarks such as the Apollo Theater and the Theresa Hotel, where Ray Charles wrote his famous song Hir the Road Jack. Passengers can also stop off at a "soul food" restaurant where they can enjoy African American food.
